



RESTRICTED SUBSTANCES POLICY

By signing the letter of compliance with the Fred Perry Restricted Substance List the supplier certifies that all articles delivered by the supplier to Fred Perry Ltd are produced in compliance with REACH and all additional global restrictions relating to residues of harmful substances listed on the Fred Perry Restricted Substances List. The supplier accepts they will be held liable for all losses and damages caused by non-compliance. Such losses and damages are specified in the Fred Perry buying terms.

Furthermore, by signing this letter the supplier accepts responsibility for the following;

1. Communicating and ensuring compliance to the Fred Perry Restricted Substances List to all parties involved in the production process of Fred Perry merchandise.
2. At their expense, performing specified independent testing from a testing house accredited with ISO 17025 or equivalent by a recognised body such as UKAS or HOKLAS for specific orders to verify compliance with the Fred Perry Restricted Substances List and submitting those test reports to Fred Perry.
3. Remaining up to date with the latest version of the Fred Perry Restricted Substances List which will be updated in accordance with new REACH and global legislation.

4. Remaining up to date with REACH Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for authorization of the Regulation EC No 1907/2006 of the European parliament of the Council REACH:
5. Disclosing the presence of any restricted substances and SVHC's in products within 35 days on request.

The supplier accepts that Fred Perry, as the buyer, reserve the right to conduct independent testing on any specified order at any point in the production process, delivery, and sale or after sale to ensure that articles produced for Fred Perry are in compliance with their Restricted Substances List.
